

Welcome to Holy Trinity, it's lovely to have you join us today.

You are welcome to sit on your own or with others. People may ask what you prefer.

Please feel free to ask questions of the person who greeted you at the door or anyone else in church today.

Toilets are located at the end of the passage found through the right-hand door at the front of the church (the one nearest the eagle bible-stand).

As a courtesy to everyone, we ask that mobile phones are switched off or put on silent mode during the service.

If you're joining us for a Sunday service there's a few things that might be helpful.

- Each Sunday our service may vary, but the person leading it will let everyone know which page to be on in the service book.
- People will stand or kneel at different parts of the service, you're welcome to do the same or just remain sitting if you prefer.
- During the third song in the service (often referred to as the 'offertory hymn') a collection bag will be passed round. The money collected is used to support the upkeep and activities of our parish. Please feel free to give a donation if you're able, otherwise just pass the bag to the next person.
- If it is a service that involves Holy Communion (also known as the Eucharist), all are welcome to come forward and have Communion (eat the bread and wine).
